## **IMPORTANT NOTE:-**

✓ Parents are requested to deposit school fee for the month of May & June by May 15, 2025 failing which fine will be charged.

- ✓ Please do not send your ward/s to school only for writing the test, when they are unwell.
- ✓ Regular admission for class XI will commence from the very next day of the declaration
  of Class X Board Result.
- ✓ Summer Vacation is from June 01 to July 09, 2025. However, the school office will remain open from June 02 to June 10, 2025 between 8:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. and will reopen on July 01, 2025 after the summer vacation.
- ✓ Students are strictly warned not to wear low waist tight fitting trousers with narrow bottoms. Students must come to school neatly dressed up. Stylish long hair with spikes, application of hair gel, strong sprays, wearing any kind of jewelry or fancy/smart watches and bringing mobile phone to school etc. is strictly banned. If the mobile phone/smart watches is found, it will be confiscated. Girls should wear divided skirts only and these should be up to knee length.
- ✓ The parents are requested to pick their ward/s on time. If any untoward incident takes place, the school will not be responsible.
